

Demonstration on cultivation of Shitake Mushroom organized at Phek Government College

A Demonstration program on Cultivation of Shiitake Mushroom (*Lentinula edodes*) using logs was organized by Department of Botany, Phek Government College on the 31st of March 2023 at the Skill Centre of the college.

The trainers of the demonstration program were Dr. Neilhousano Nakhro and Ms. Shesalu Lohe, Assistant Professors, Department of Botany, PGC. Dr. Neilhousano Nakhro gave a talk on the importance of shiitake mushroom, procedures involved in the cultivation, and the steps for its maintenance. The students of B. Sc. 6th semester Botany honours and B.A. 6th semester taking Mushroom cultivation as choice-based credit paper provided the hands-on-demonstration on the cultivation technique. Demonstration on preparation of logs, inoculation of spawn, sealing and stacking methods were carried out by them.

Dr. T. Tiakaba Jamir, Principal, Phek Government College emphasized on the need to organize more programs related to development of skill during the interactive session. He also added that with the implementation of National Education Policy 2020 such programs will become more significant.

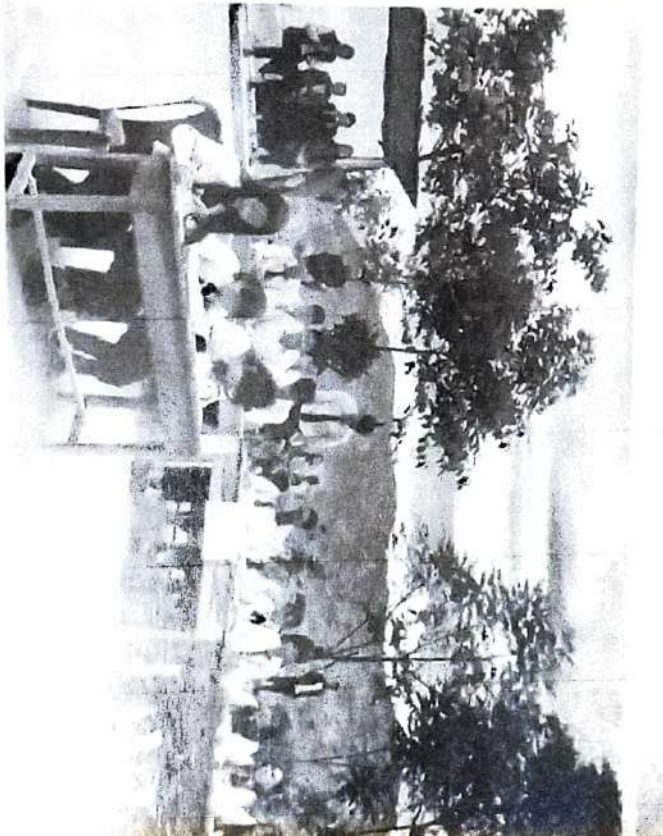

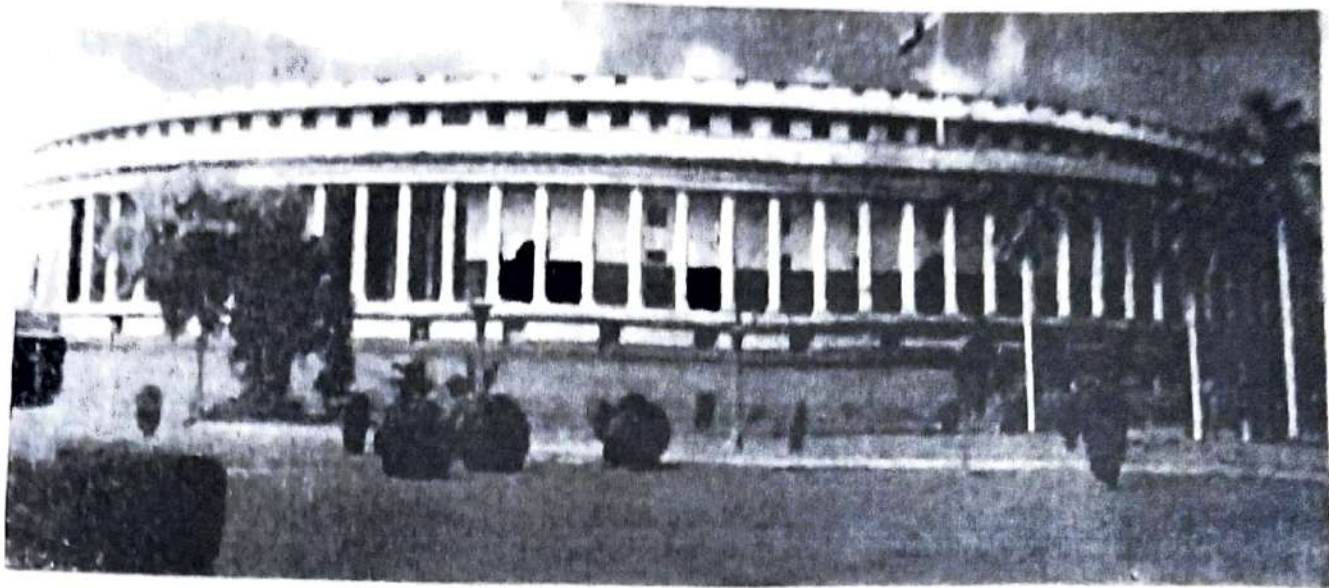
